Good Shepherd Medical Center has made available to physicians an application for the Apple iPhone that can be used to access clinical data. This application provides access to the most important clinical data in the medical center. Currently, the application provides access to:

1. Lab, microbiology, pathology and blood bank
2. Radiology dictation and reports
3. Medication list
4. Medical record reports such as:
 - a. History and physical
 - b. Discharge summary
 - c. Consultation
 - d. Cardiology

- e. ED physician notes
- f. ED nurse notes
- 5. Visit history
- 6. Bed alert status
- 7. Patient demographics

This data is available across all visits from as far back:

- Lab/blood bank – all visits since 2/1/09.
- Micro/path – All visits since ~12/23/09 (there didn't seem to be a need for historical results)
- Radiology dictation – All exams since ~5/15/09
- Radiology reports – All that have not been purged from Meditech
- Medications – current visit
- Visit history – all in Meditech

As a physician who practices at GSMC you have access to this data on an iPhone while working in the hospital, in your office, or at home. The goal of this project is to make it easier for physicians to treat patients at GSMC.
